

Fuel price report (August 2018)

Unleaded prices have risen 1.1p from 128.4 p/litre to 129.5 p/litre. Diesel prices have gone up by 0.7p from 131.6 p/litre to 132.3 p/litre. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has shrunk to 2.8 p/litre.

The **South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 130.4 p/litre.

The **North East, Yorkshire & Humberside, and Northern Ireland** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 128.8 p/litre.

The **South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 133.1 p/litre. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 131.0 p/litre.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 125.8 p/litre. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has increased to 3.7 p/litre.
