

# Fuel price report (September 2018)

Unleaded prices have risen 1.8p from 129.5p/litre to 131.3p/litre.

Diesel prices have gone up by 2.1p from 132.3p/litre to 134.4p/litre.

The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 3.1p/litre.

- The **South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 132.2p/litre.
- The **North West** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 130.3p/litre.
- The **South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 135.1p/litre.
- **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 133p/litre.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 128.2p/litre. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has fallen to 3.1p/litre.
