

## FUEL PRICE REPORT JUNE 2008

This month has seen record rises in the price of both petrol and diesel, overtaking last months record increases. The price of crude reached nearly \$140 a barrel.

Nationally, **unleaded** prices have risen by 5.6ppl to 118.2ppl in the past month. **Diesel** prices have risen by 7.4ppl to 131.6ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has risen from 11.6ppl to 13.4ppl

The South East recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 118.9ppl followed by the **London** at 118.8ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** again recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 116.9ppl. **Scotland** and the **South West** recorded the highest **diesel** price at 132.2ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** still have the cheapest **diesel** at 130.7ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** also rose over the month by 5.8ppl to 116.5ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has fallen slightly to 1.7ppl. Overseas prices have risen. The UK has the tenth highest **unleaded** price in Europe and the second highest **diesel** price.
