June 2010



## FUEL PRICE REPORT JUNE 2010

Petrol prices have fallen substantially in the past month, but not evenly across the UK. Although the average UK reduction largely reflects falls in the wholesale price, there are large built-up areas of the South, South East, Home Counties and rural Midlands, covering more than a million people, where supermarket and other retailer price falls have been substantially less. Barrel price is \$78.

**Unleaded** prices have fallen by 3.4ppl from 121.5ppl to 118.1ppl. **Diesel** prices have also fallen, by 2.4ppl, from 122.9ppl to 120.5ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has risen from 1.4ppl to 2.4ppl.

**London** recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 119.3ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 116.8ppl. **Northern Ireland** recorded the highest **diesel** price at 121.3ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** have the cheapest **diesel** at 119.5ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** also fell over the month by 3.7ppl to 116.3ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 1.8ppl.

The UK has the eighth highest **unleaded** price in Europe and the second highest **diesel** price.
