FUEL PRICE REPORT – APRIL 2014

The price of petrol in the UK has begun to rise again although the average still remains below 130p a litre. The cost of diesel continues to trickle downwards. Oil: \$108 a barrel.

Unleaded prices are up 0.2p from 129.5 ppl to 129.7ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 0.3p from 136.6 ppl to 136.3 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has shrunk to 6.6 ppl.

Northern Ireland has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 130.7 ppl. **Yorkshire & Humberside** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 129.3 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 136.9 ppl. **London** has the cheapest **diesel** at 135.8 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** remain at 127.5 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 2.2 ppl.
