

Fuel price report (August 2016)

Unleaded prices have dropped 2p from 112.2 ppl to 110.2 ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 1.5p from 112.7 ppl to 111.2 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 1 ppl.

The South East has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 110.7 ppl. **The North** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 109.5 ppl. **East Anglia** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 111.8 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 110.0 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 106.5 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 3.7 ppl.

Unleaded prices for France, Germany and Finland are for E10 – petrol containing 10% ethanol.
