FUEL PRICE REPORT FEBRUARY 2012

The average pump price for diesel in the UK has overtaken the record set in May of last year. Petrol prices continue to rise but remain nearly 2.5p off the record. As happened last year, trouble in the Middle East has spurred speculator activity in the oil and fuel markets, although a slightly stronger pound has taken away some of the sting. Oil is \$118 a barrel.

Unleaded prices have risen by 1.5ppl from 133.5ppl to 135.0ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen by 0.9ppl from 141.9ppl to 142.8ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has fallen to 7.8ppl.

Northern Ireland recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 135.9ppl. **The North** recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 134.2ppl. **Northern Ireland** recorded the highest **diesel** price at 143.5ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** and the **North** have the cheapest **diesel** at 142.3ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** rose by 1.5ppl to 133.3ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has remained at 1.7ppl.

The UK has the ninth highest petrol price in Europe and the second highest diesel price.
