

Fuel Price Report

July 2014



After rising by around a penny a litre since mid June, average petrol and diesel prices have started to fall again. Oil: \$105 a barrel.

Unleaded prices are up 1.1p from 130.5 ppl to 131.6 ppl. **Diesel** prices have increased 0.4p from 135.7 ppl to 136.1 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has shrunk to 4.5 ppl.

Northern Ireland has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 132.4 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 131.2 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 136.6 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has the cheapest **diesel** at 135.7 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have risen to 129.9 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has shrunk to 1.7 ppl.
