## **Fuel Price Report**

#### June 2013



After 12 months of price swings at the pump, petrol and diesel prices have remained relatively quiet. Even so both have seen an average increase of around a penny a litre over the past month as a stronger pound failed to offset all the impact of higher oil and wholesale fuel costs.

Oil: \$104 a barrel

**Unleaded** prices have risen by 1.2ppl from 133.4ppl to 134.6ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen by 1.0ppl from 138.2ppl to 139.2ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has fallen to 4.6ppl.

**Northern Ireland** recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 135.8ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 134.1ppl. **Northern Ireland** recorded the highest **diesel** price at 139.8ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has the cheapest **diesel** at 138.7ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** rose by 1.6ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has fallen to 1.6ppl.

The UK has the ninth highest petrol price and the second highest diesel price.
