Fuel Price Report

June 2014



Rising oil prices continue to push up the pump price of petrol, although a stronger pound has reduced the impact. Surplus diesel supply continues to lower the forecourt price. Oil: \$113 a barrel.

Unleaded prices are up 0.6p from 129.9 ppl to 130.5 ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 0.5p from 136.2 ppl to 135.7 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has shrunk to 5.2 ppl.

Northern Ireland has recorded the highest price for unleaded at 131.3 ppl. The North has recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 130.1 ppl. Scotland has recorded the highest diesel price at 136.3 ppl. London has the cheapest diesel at 135.4 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have risen to 128.5 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has grown to 2.0 ppl.
