FUEL PRICE REPORT MARCH 2013

After the third fuel price surge in 12 months, creating 8p-10p price swings in March and September last year and also this February, petrol and diesel prices are starting to fall. However, a weaker pound means that pump prices will still be 3p adrift of where they started the year. Oil: \$109

Unleaded prices have risen by 2.0ppl from137.9ppl to 139.9ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen by 1.6ppl from 144.8ppl to 146.4ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has fallen to 6.5ppl.

Northern Ireland recorded the highest price for unleaded at 141.1ppl. Yorkshire and Humberside and the North recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 139.3ppl. The South East recorded the highest diesel price at 147.1ppl. Yorkshire and Humberside has the cheapest diesel at 145.7ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** rose by 2.9ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has fallen to 1.3ppl.

The UK has the eleventh highest petrol price and the fourth highest diesel price.
