

# Fuel Price Report

March 2016



**Unleaded** prices have risen 1p from 102.0 ppl to 103.0 ppl. **Diesel** prices have jumped 2.3p from 101.0 ppl to 103.3 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has shrunk to 0.3 ppl.

The **North West** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 103.3 ppl. **Wales and Yorkshire & Humberside** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 102.6 ppl. The **South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 103.6 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 102.0 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 100.3 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has grown to 2.7 ppl.
