

# Fuel Price Report

May 2015



## FUEL PRICE REPORT – MAY 2015

A further 3p-a-litre increase in the cost of petrol this month has taken the overall rise since 1 February to 10p a litre or £5 extra per tank. Diesel remains significantly more expensive than petrol, despite costing only 0.5p a litre more at wholesale level this month.

**Unleaded** prices are up 3.1p from 113.3 ppl to 116.4 ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen 1.9p from 118.8 ppl to 120.7 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has shrunk to 4.3 ppl.

**Scotland** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 117.0 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 116.0 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 121.3 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 119.4 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have risen to 114.4 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** remains at 2.0 ppl.
