

Fuel Price Report

May 2016



Unleaded prices have risen 1.9p from 107.3 ppl to 109.2 ppl. **Diesel** prices have jumped 2.2p from 106.9 ppl to 109.1 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has shrunk to 0.1 ppl.

The South East and West Midlands have recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 109.6 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 108.5 ppl. **The South East** has also recorded the highest **diesel** price at 109.7 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 107.5 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 106.7 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has dropped to 2.5 ppl.
