

Fuel Price Report

November 2014



Pump prices have continued their slide as the oil price loses value. However, a drop in the intensity of the price battle between supermarkets has re-orientated regional prices back to a more normal pattern.

Unleaded prices are down 4.3p from 127.2 ppl to 122.9 ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 3.9p from 131.3 ppl to 127.4 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has increased to 4.5 ppl.

London has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 123.2 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 122.7 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 128.0 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has the cheapest **diesel** at 127.2 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have fallen to 121.3 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has shrunk to 1.6 ppl.
