FUEL PRICE REPORT - SEPTEMBER 2013

Average UK petrol prices have barely risen since last month although improved stability in the Middle East and a stronger pound point the way towards lower pump prices soon. The cost of diesel has also gone up, but by just 0.6p a litre. Oil: \$111 a barrel.

Unleaded prices have risen by 0.1ppl from 137.5ppl to 137.6ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen by 0.6ppl from 141.9ppl to 142.5ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has grown to 4.9ppl.

Northern Ireland recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 138.6ppl. **London** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 137.1ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 143.4ppl. **London** has the cheapest **diesel** at 141.8ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** are unchanged. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has increased to 1.9ppl.

In Europe, the UK has the 7th highest petrol price and the 2nd highest diesel price.
