

# Fuel Price Report

September 2014



Despite the pound losing value against the dollar (used for trading oil and wholesale fuel), UK pump prices have continued to fall. A steadying of the pound should allow lower oil prices to push costs down further.

**Unleaded** prices are down 0.5p from 129.7 ppl to 129.2 ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 0.5p from 133.9 ppl to 133.4 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel remains at 4.2 ppl.

**East Anglia** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 129.7 ppl. **London and Yorkshire and Humberside** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 128.9 ppl. **East Anglia** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 134.0 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** and the **North West** have the cheapest **diesel** at 133.0 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have fallen to 127.6 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** remains at 1.6 ppl.
