

Fuel Price Report

September 2015



Diesel remains cheaper on average than petrol at the pump although wholesale prices have started to reverse that again. Although petrol is 18p a litre cheaper than last year, official figures show no revival in demand for the fuel.

Unleaded prices have dropped 3.6p from 114.8 ppl 111.2ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 1.5p from 111.9 ppl to 110.4 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has dropped to minus 0.8 ppl, having been minus 2.9ppl last month.

The **North** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 111.7 ppl. **Wales and the East Midlands** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 111.0 ppl. **East Anglia** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 111.1 ppl. **Yorkshire & Humberside** has the cheapest **diesel** at 110.0 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have fallen to 109.2 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has grown to 2 ppl.
