

# Fuel price report (June 2018)

Unleaded prices have gone up 3.3p from 125.5 ppl to 128.8 ppl. Diesel prices have increased by 3.4p from 128.3 ppl to 131.7 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 2.9 ppl.

The **South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 129.5 ppl. **Yorkshire & Humberside** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 127.9 ppl. The **South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 132.4 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 130.8 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 124.7 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 4.1 ppl.
