Unleaded prices have risen 1.5p from 115.1 pence/litre to 116.6 pence/litre. **Diesel** prices have risen 1.5p from 116.9 pence/litre to 118.4 pence/litre. The price difference between diesel and unleaded remains at 1.8 pence/litre.

The South East and East Anglia have recorded the highest price for unleaded at 117.1 pence/litre. Northern Ireland has recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 115.2 pence/litre. The East Anglia has recorded the highest diesel price at 119.1 pence/litre. Northern Ireland has the cheapest diesel at 116.8 pence/litre.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 114.3 pence/litre. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has shrunk to 2.3 pence/litre.
