**Unleaded** prices have risen 3.3p from 111.8 ppl to 115.1 ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen 3.8p from 113.1 ppl to 116.9 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 1.8 ppl.

The South East has recorded the highest price for unleaded at 115.6 ppl. Northern Ireland has recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 113.8 ppl. The South East has recorded the highest diesel price at 117.4 ppl. Northern Ireland has the cheapest diesel at 115.5 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 112.0 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has grown to 3.1 ppl.
