FUEL PRICE REPORT – APRIL 2015

Pump prices continue to rise as oil prices climbed above \$60 a barrel for the second time this year. Diesel remains significantly more expensive than petrol, despite near parity at wholesale cost level this month.

Unleaded prices are up 1.4p from 111.9 ppl to 113.3 ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen 0.6p from 118.2 ppl to 118.8 ppl. The price difference between unleaded and diesel has shrunk to 5.5 ppl.

Scotland has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 113.8 ppl. **London, South East, and Yorkshire and Humberside** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 113.1 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 119.6 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 117.7 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have risen to 111.3 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** remains at 2.0 ppl.
