

Fuel Price Report

October 2015



In line with wholesale costs, diesel has once again become more expensive than petrol at the pump. Fierce supermarket competition has opened a significant average price gap between them and most other retailers.

Unleaded prices have dropped 2p from 111.2 ppl 109.2ppl. **Diesel** prices have risen 0.6p from 110.4 ppl to 111.0 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has risen to 0.8pp having been minus 0.8 ppl last month.

East Anglia has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 109.6 ppl. **Yorkshire and Humberside** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 109.0 ppl. **Scotland** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 111.6 ppl. **Yorkshire & Humberside and Northern Ireland** have the cheapest **diesel** at 110.6 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** have fallen to 107.1 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has grown to 2.1 ppl.
