Are there any requirements to have a free charge point installed?

Yes:

- There must be sufficient parking bays available (2 per charge point)
- There must be 24/7 access (or as close to 24/7 as possible) to the parking bays with charge points
- Sufficient power must be available dependent on the charge points
- The charge point must be available to all POLAR members, not just guests

How much will it cost my business?

Chargemaster will install the unit free of charge, including bay marking, signage and the cost of the units. They will also maintain the unit at their own cost.

The power to the unit will generally come out of the existing supply to the business so any energy costs will be part of your standard energy bill. You will have the choice of charging Chargemaster back for any energy usage which is then passed on to the customer, or to pay for this themselves as an added incentive to electric car drivers.
