Touring Tips

The following is additional to our [general advice for motoring in Europe](#).

Driving licence

A UK licence holder must be at least 18 years old to drive a temporarily imported car or motorcycle in Andorra.

Motor Insurance

You must have a minimum of third party insurance.

Fuel

- Leaded (98 octane), unleaded petrol (95 & 98 octane) and Diesel (Gasoil) are available but LPG is not.
- You must not carry petrol in a can.
- Credit cards are accepted at most filling stations but check with your card issuer for usage in Andorra before travel.

Speed limits

(Standard legal limits, which may be varied by signs, for private vehicles with or without trailers)

- Built-up areas: 31 mph (50 km/h)
- Outside built-up areas: between 37 and 55 mph (60 and 90 km/h).

Seat belts

Front seat occupants must wear seat belts if fitted.

Passengers/children in cars

Children under 10 years and less than 1.5m tall must use an EU approved restraint adapted to their size. If they are travelling in the front of the car, the airbag must be deactivated.

Lights

You should use dipped headlights in poor daytime visibility.

Motorcycles

- You must use dipped headlights during the day.
- You must wear a crash helmet.

Drinking and driving

The legal limit of alcohol is 50 milligrams per 100 millilitres of blood.

Fines

On-the-spot.

It's compulsory to carry the following in Andorra

- Spare bulbs
- Warning triangle
- Reflective yellow waistcoat

Other rules/requirements in Andorra

Winter tyres are recommended.

Snow chains must be used when road conditions or signs indicate.
