Why recycle?

Unwanted electrical equipment is the UK's fastest growing type of waste.

Many electrical items can be repaired or recycled, saving natural resources and the environment.

If you don't recycle electrical equipment, it will end up in landfill where hazardous substances can leak and cause soil and water contamination – harming wildlife and human health.



So never throw any electrical equipment in your bin.

Electrical equipment that can be recycled is marked with the crossed-out wheelie bin symbol.

What is WEEE?

Waste electrical and electronic equipment regulations (WEEE) require countries to collect and environmentally friendly process such items.

How are we helping?

In the UK distributors and retailers must provide a system which allows all customers buying new electrical equipment the opportunity to recycle their old items free of charge.
