

Fuel price report (February 2017)

Unleaded prices have risen 0.6p from 119.5 p/litre to 120.1 p/litre.

Diesel prices have risen 0.3p from 122.0 p/litre to 122.3 p/litre.

The price difference between diesel and unleaded has fallen to 2.2 p/litre.

The South East has recorded the highest price for unleaded at 121.0 p/litre. The North East has recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 119.0 p/litre. The South East has recorded the highest diesel price at 123.2 p/litre. Northern Ireland and the North East have the cheapest diesel at 121.2 p/litre.

Supermarket prices for unleaded now average 118.0 p/litre. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for unleaded has shrunk to 2.1 p/litre.
