Fuel Price Report

July 2016



Unleaded prices have risen 0.6p from 111.6 ppl to 112.2 ppl. **Diesel** prices have jumped 0.9p from 111.8 ppl to 112.7 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 0.2 ppl.

The South East has recorded the highest price for unleaded at 112.6 ppl. Northern Ireland has recorded the lowest price for unleaded at 111.2 ppl. The South East has also recorded the highest diesel price at 113.3 ppl. Northern Ireland has the cheapest diesel at 111.3 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 109.6 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has risen to 2.6 ppl.
