

# Fuel price report (March 2017)

**Unleaded** prices have fallen 0.4p from 120.1 ppl to 119.7 ppl. **Diesel** prices have fallen 0.5p from 122.3 ppl to 121.8 ppl. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has fallen to 2.1 ppl.

**The South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 120.4 ppl. **Northern Ireland and Wales** have recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 118.8 ppl. **The South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 122.5 ppl. **Northern Ireland and the North East** have the cheapest **diesel** at 120.8 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 116.6 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has jumped to 3.1 ppl.
